# National Professional Qualification for Senior Leadership (NPQSL)

**We are now recruiting for September 2014.**

NPQSL is a nationally accredited qualification aimed at school leaders with cross-team leadership responsibilities including deputy and assistant heads, SENCOs, ASTs and experienced middle leaders.

The programme structure is flexible allowing you to choose modules that most interest you; each being a mix of online, face to face and in-school learning. The programme is generally completed in 12 months (but can be completed quicker depending on experience).

Each participant will study two essential modules and a choice of two elective modules, before reaching the final assessment stage at the end of the programme.

## **Where and when is NPQSL being delivered?**

L.E.A.D. Academy Trust holds a license to deliver NPQSL on behalf of the National College for Teaching and Leadership (NCTL) across the East Midlands. We work with partner schools across the region, to enable us to recruit and train in a number of locations – always ensuring that there is a cohort local to you, wherever you are in the East Midlands.

We deliver the qualification in close partnership with Best Practice Network, a nationally recognised leadership training provider. This ensures we have access to the highest quality facilitators, leadership practice and online resources – assuring the very best value for money for all our participants.

### How do I apply?

Applications for any of the above cohort groups must be made online on the L.E.A.D. application form, which can be found on our website at [www.leadurbantsa.co.uk/cpd/npgsl](http://www.leadurbantsa.co.uk/cpd/npgsl)

The closing date is **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> June**. After this date, applications will be assessed and applicants informed of the outcomes.

A full programme guide, training dates and venues will then be confirmed to successful applicants before the end of the summer term.

Programmes will start towards the end of September 2014.

### What will it cost?

The cost of undertaking NPQSL depends on the phase and size of your school. The full cost is £1400, but state funded schools and academies can access scholarships to reduce the costs to the levels below.

- For secondary schools with more than 500 on roll – cost is £1,190 per participant
- For primary schools with more than 250 on roll – cost is £1,190 per participant
- For primary schools with between 100 and 250 on roll – cost is £700 per participant
- For primary schools with 100 pupils or fewer on roll and secondary schools with 500 or fewer pupils on roll – no cost



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Exemptions to one of the elective modules (and a reduction in the programme fee) are available in certain cases. Information on this is available on our website.
